NEW WIRELESS INTERNET AT THE GAINESVILLE REGIONAL AIRPORT

Gainesville, FL – February 4, 2004 – Gainesville Regional Airport is pleased to announce that wireless and wired high-speed Internet access will be provided in the terminal and public areas as a no-cost amenity to travelers flying Gainesville.

On Friday, February 6th at 2:00 p.m., there will be an official ceremony of “Logging-On the Internet” in the main terminal. [HotzSpotz](#), which is a locally owned company that specialized in installing and operating wireless access points for commercial or other applications, designed and created the system that is powered by Cox Communications High Speed Internet.

The wireless zones will include the main waiting area, the secure holding area, the courtyard, the snack and lounge area and the baggage claim / rental car area. Also, there are six (6) wired connections for those without Wi-Fi enabled computers. Four (4) wired connections are located in the main waiting area and two (2) are located in the secure holding area.

When passengers access the Internet at the Airport, they will first be directed to a custom web portal designed by HotzSpotz for the Gainesville Regional Airport.

Signs and information sheets will be posted throughout the airport by HotzSpotz and Cox to alert travelers to the availability of the service.

“The airport is pleased to offer this new service to our valued passengers,” said Rick Crider, CEO of the airport.
