# POSITION: AIRPORT GROUNDS MAINTENANCE TECHNICIAN I

## **DEPARTMENT: FACILITIES AND MAINTENANCE (400)**

## **OVERALL OBJECTIVE OF JOB**

Provide general maintenance and repair of airport grounds, buildings, and equipment in order to preserve and improve functionality, security, safety and aesthetics.

## **CLASSIFICATION STANDARDS**

Positions allocated to this classification report to a designated supervisor and work under close supervision. This is entry level work.

# **ESSENTIAL JOB FUNCTIONS**

- 1. Performs general grounds and building maintenance as directed by the Airport Maintenance Technician Lead.
- 2. Performs landscaping duties including mowing, trimming, and clearing debris to maintain a clean and safe environment.
- 3. Operates a variety of ground maintenance equipment, including backpack blowers, weed trimmers, brush cutters, stick edgers, push mowers, zero-turn mowers, and utility vehicles.
- 4. Operates vehicles and heavy equipment such as tractors with batwing, arm tractors, skid loaders with various implements, backhoes, dump trucks, aerial lifts, and other machinery as trained.
- 5. Performs perimeter fence inspections and completes timely repairs.

- 6. Transports materials to and from locations within airport grounds or offsite as directed.
- 7. Pressure washes sidewalks, buildings, and runway markings.
- 8. Operates tar machine for asphalt repair and maintenance.
- 9. Paints using a spray gun, walk-behind paint sprayer, rollers, or brushes.
- 10. Conducts preventive maintenance, diagnoses malfunctions, and performs simple repairs on equipment for which training has been provided.
- 11. Works effectively both independently and as part of a team.
- 12. Works continuously in outdoor weather conditions.
- 13. Performs other related duties as assigned.
- 14. Maintains regular, consistent attendance and punctuality.

## MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

- Completion of high school degree or GED equivalent plus six months experience in either the building trades or building and grounds maintenance, or any equivalent combination of education and experience.
- Ability to acquire the skills necessary to operate a full complement of maintenance vehicles and equipment on airport and surrounding property, to include an active airfield, safely and without threat to aircraft, people and self.
- Physical strength and agility sufficient to permit working overhead, and with equipment or objects weighing over 30 pounds. Must have ability to lift up to 100 pounds as necessary.
- Must be able to understand the English language and speak in an understandable manner in order to carry out essential job duties.

# OTHER QUALIFICATIONS

- Ability to safely and successfully perform essential job functions consistent with the ADA, FMLA and other federal, state and local standards, including meeting qualitative and/or quantitative productivity standards.
- Ability to maintain reasonably regular, punctual attendance consistent with the ADA, FMLA and other federal, state and local standards.

#### AIRPORT GOUNDS MAINTENANCE TECHNICIAN I JOB DESCRIPTION

- Must be able to successfully pass a fingerprint-based criminal history records check, TSA Security Threat Assessment and personal background check prior to employment.
- Compliance with all personnel policies.

## KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS AND ABILITIES REQUIRED

- Skilled in general maintenance and construction methods, tools, and practices. Proficient in the safe and efficient use of various hand tools, including shovels, rakes, hedge trimmers, loppers, and shears.
- Knowledge of general practices applied in care and safe operation of a wide variety of maintenance equipment.
- Knowledge and ability to detect defects in equipment and make proper adjustments and emergency repairs.
- Ability to perform manual labor and operate motorized equipment.
- Ability to correctly use personal protective equipment (PPE) appropriate to jobs performed.
- Knowledge of the occupational hazards and required safety precautions, and the ability to exercise care and use of various tools and equipment.
- Possession of a Commercial Drivers License or the ability to obtain a CDL within one year, if requested.
- Ability to follow oral and written instructions.
- Ability to function independently, have flexibility, and work effectively with clients, co-workers and others.

- Requires emotional resilience, physical strength, agility, and the stamina to perform demanding tasks in varying conditions.
